Three Ames High School seniors each received a \$1,000 scholarship from the Ames High School Alumni Association.

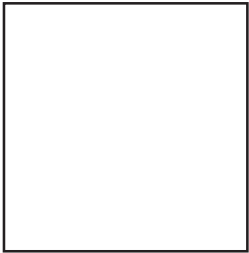

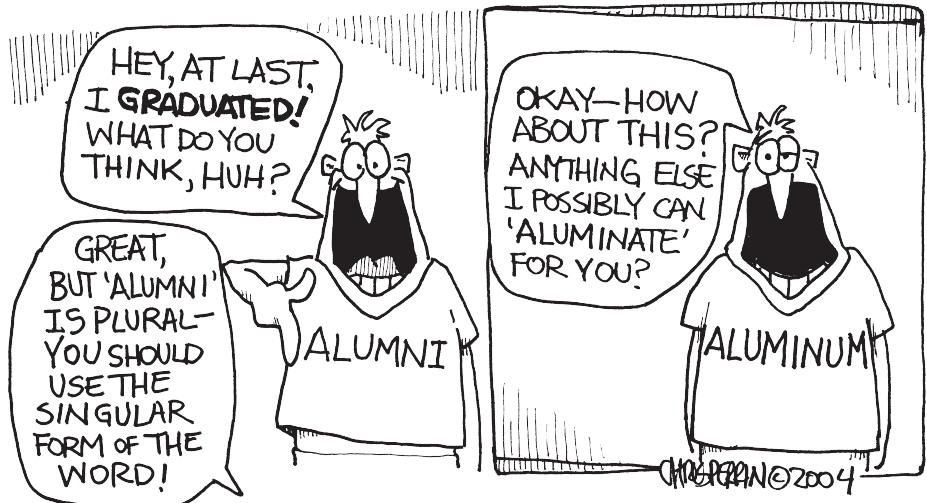
### Golf Outing News

## ...Aiming High

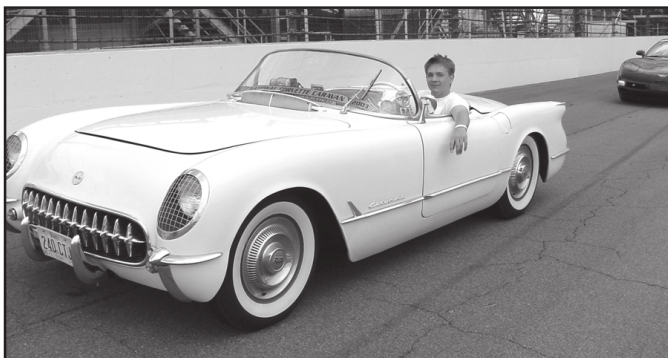
Steve Ward '69 has written a book titled *Where Do You Go When You're Afraid of the Trees?*, a book describing his own history of abuse as a child. He is now an ordained pastor in Ames and the head of a regional Court Appointed Special Advocates program that helps abused and neglected children in the juvenile justice system. Ward wants to bring the issue of child abuse out of the shadows and into a statewide discussion, making it easier for children to come forward.

Brian Smith '77 has been named President of Editorial Photographers, an organization of 4,100 magazine and newspaper photographers. He is a Pulitzer Prize, World Press Photo and Picture of the Year winner. His assignments from ESPN the Magazine, Sports Illustrated, Time, Fortune, People, New York Times Magazine, and New York Stock Exchange have taken him to six continents. His celebrity portraits are syndicated by Corbis Outline.

Eduardo Rosa III '88 was one of more than 80 hero soldiers from Operations Iraqi Freedom and Enduring Freedom honored during the "All-American" Bowl all-star high school football game sponsored by the U.S. Army. Rosa was awarded the Bronze Star for his service during Operation Iraqi Freedom. He graduated from Iowa State University in 1994.

Fred Hoiberg '91 was honored by having his Iowa State University basketball jersey retired. Hoiberg was nicknamed "The Mayor," showing his local popularity. He is the only Cyclone to tally at least 1,400 points, 600 rebounds, 300 assists and 175 steals. Hoiberg, an All-American in 1995, was the leading scorer on the 1994-95 ISU team that won a then school-record 23 games. He played on three NCAA Tournament teams and currently plays in the NBA for the Minnesota Timberwolves.

Blake Hendrickson '01 and his grandfather, Ed Hendrickson, Sr, drove Ed's 1954 Corvette 2032 miles round trip from Ames, IA to Bowling Green, Kentucky to attend the 50th anniversary of the Corvette in July 2003. Of the 10,000 other Corvettes, only one 1953 and one other 1954 Corvette attended. Pictured is Blake driving the Corvette around the Indianapolis 500 Speedway.



## AHS Today

### Ames Teacher Wins Top Award

AHS math teacher Virginia Swenson won a Presidential Award for Excellence in Mathematics and Science Teaching, the nation's highest commendation of its kind. Swenson is Iowa's only presidential award recipient for math teaching and one of 95 teachers nationwide to be recognized with a 2003 award and \$10,000. Winners were selected by a panel of math and science education experts who based their decisions on classroom innovation, subject knowledge, professional development and organizational involvement.

### Swimming Coach in Hall of Fame

Former longtime AHS swimming coach Mike Wittmer was inducted into the Iowa High School Swimming Coaches Association Hall of Fame. Wittmer coached both boys' and girls' swimming at AHS for 29 years. His teams qualified for the state meet and scored points at state in at least one event every year he was coach. The highlight of Wittmer's coaching run was a boys' state swimming championship in 1982. Wittmer's teams finished second in the state in 1972, 1974, 1975 and 1995, and he was named coach of the year three times.

### Swimming Honors and Coach of the Year

The boys' swimming team placed first in the district meet, winning nine of 11 events. Coach Flannery took Coach of the Year honors and Bobby Sundvold earned District Athlete of the Year honors. Way to go, swimmers!

### WordMasters

Two teams of students representing AHS have won the highest honors in this year's WordMasters Challenge, a national competition for high school students requiring close reading and analysis of many different kinds of prose and poetry. Participating with 274 high school teams from across the country, the school's 11th and 12th grade Gold Division team tied for ninth place in the nation. Also, the school's 9th and 10th grade Blue Division team placed seventh nationwide. The teams were supervised by Linda Martens, Cecilia Horner, John Forssman and James Webb.

### Drill Team Wins National Competition

The Ames High School drill team returned from the Champion Dance Nationals in Florida with 8 trophies. The 18 girls on the drill team's gold squad won first place for their pompom routine and seconds for their prop and hip hop performances. The 14 girls on the silver squad won first for their high-kick routine and seconds for their jazz and lyrical performances. The drill team also took home thirds for a solo and a trio performance. The team's coach, Sarah Buss, says it takes three things to be a successful team: the ability to change, technique and attitude. It also took raising \$20,000, 3-hour practices and a 60-hour bus ride, but no one was complaining. This year was the first time Ames dancers had competed at the national level.

## Mini-Grants for Ames High School Projects

Each year the Ames Education Foundation awards mini-grants to faculty to provide special projects in the classroom. Funded projects directly involve students, are innovative and incorporate matching funds or community resources.

This year 36 proposals requesting over \$16,000 were received. We were able to fund, either completely or partially, 25 projects, for a total of \$8,650. Ames High School received awards for the following mini-grants:

DVD in the Classroom (Kristi Minion) - The project brought video technology into the classroom by providing a DVD system. The AHS Alumni Association provided an additional \$400 funding to purchase the entire system.

Touring the Universe Through Binoculars (DeAnna Tibben) - Funds were used to purchase copies of the Touring the Universe Through Binoculars, a guide to help students observe the moon, planets, and stellar objects.

Moving Ames High Debate & Forensics to Excellence (Aiddy Phomvisay) - Support existing programming by providing training materials to the thirty new students on the Ames High Debate Team.

Dictionary Training (Anne Marie Kern & Shaeley Santiago) - The funds helped to purchase and integrate a class set of English dictionaries to support the learning of words in a more comprehensible fashion for English Language Learners.

## Pasley Captures #10 Nazi

The following is reprinted from the May 10, 1945 issue of The Milepost, a weekly newspaper in Ames. Those referred to in the article are Robert G. Pasley '33, his wife, Mary (Abbott) Pasley '34 and two sons, Clarke '59 and Robert '61.

Capt. Robert G. Pasley of Ames had the distinction of capturing one of the leading Nazi officials according to a broadcast from WHO, Des Moines radio station. It is reported that the former Ames man was alone when he made the capture at the villa of the prominent Nazi, Dr. Wilhelm Frick. The German was a former interior minister, the predecessor of Heinrich Himmler.

Capt. Pasley, son of Mr. and Mrs. C. H. Pasley, of Ames, has been with the Allied Military Government in Germany since December 1944, and has been acting as a summary court judge.

His parents have received no information from their son about this experience as it evidently occurred too recently for him to have written home about it.

Capt. Pasley's wife and two small sons are living in Boone.

## Alumni Database and Research

There have been 22,314 graduates of AHS from 1875 through 2003. Our records show only 2.25% missing. Many of those are from countries that have no diplomatic relations with the United States. Also, I've recently located 50-75 grads that will further reduce that percentage. For years I've used switchboard.com and the Social Security Death Index (SSDI) to find lost alumni. Recently I've discovered MyFamily.com, a subscription service that is relatively cheap and often lists mom and dad as well as the missing graduate. Our database lists parents' names and birthdates, which are invaluable in the research.

What stymies us is that we have maiden names for female graduates and little else. Does anyone know a way to track down something about these graduates knowing only the maiden name? When I was looking for another source, I found one that listed the month and year of birth with the name I was seeking. Does anyone know of a source like that? I have lost track of it.

We have over 4000 names in our database for which the address is in care of (%) someone. Many of those names are fairly recent graduates. We'd like a current address for these people. Thanks to Nancy (Wallace) Burkhart '55 for helping on that one. And we think we've finally located Ren Ruggless '62. Another on our most wanted list, Colleen Grisham '54 has turned up deceased. Three more on that list still elude us, Carey Poole '59, Bruce Batman '60 and Robert Caquelin '64. If you can help us, we'd like to hear from you.

Father Tom died in Ecuador, South America, on April 22, 2004.

Tommy, as he was affectionately called, will be greatly missed by his family and the many, many friends he had worldwide. I personally feel that a large part of my life went with him. We were the best of buddies since we attended the Iowa State University nursery school together at three years of age.

We were in scouting together, attaining the rank of Eagle Scout. I would never had accomplished that feat had it not been for the encouragement and prodding of my buddy, Tommy. When our Scout Master presented us with our Eagle Scout certificates, he introduced us by saying that "Tommy and Paul are so close to each other in their friendship that when Tommy itches, Paul scratches."

We enlisted in the Army Air Corps together in 1943. We had aspirations of serving together, but, of course, that was an unrealistic goal. Tommy served in combat in WWII as a navigator on a B-29 based in Tinian-Saipan. I was a bombardier on a B-24 in New Guinea and the Philippine Islands.

Tom devoted his adult life as an ordained priest serving the spiritual needs of his beloved parishioners and friends in South America - Columbia, Chile and most recently, Ecuador, as a Maryknoll priest.

At Ames High School, Tom excelled as a student and participant in many activities, including drama and athletics. In track, he was an outstanding distance runner. The half-mile (as it was called then) was his main event, and at which he enjoyed great success.

Tommy leaves us with a legacy of loving service to his fellow man. We are blessed to have known him and to have a share of his love. The world is significantly better and richer because of his presence among us. We thank God, who he so ably served, for giving us Tom for almost 79 years.
