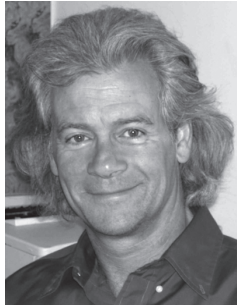
Ames High Grads Create Hilton Magic in July

Four Ames High Grads will be part of "The Hilton Magic All-Star Celebrity Weekend" benefit for Barry Stevens on Friday, July 20 and Saturday, July 21, 2007. Fred Hoiberg (AHS 1991), Chuck Harmison (AHS 1976), Ev Cochrane (AHS 1974) and Steve Burgason (AHS 1973) will be among the celebrities hosting the two-day event.

Activities include: a golf outing, an all-star celebrity basketball game, a youth basketball clinic and mini-health fair.

On February 21, 2007, Stevens, 43, a former ISU basketball player credited with helping reignite the ISU basketball program under coach Johnny Orr, died of a heart attack during a pickup basketball game at a health club in Gary, Indiana. He is survived by his sister Rhonda, his wife Sarita and their three children, daughter Arriel and sons Darius and Garius.

"Barry Stevens was the greatest player in the history of Iowa State other than Jeff Grayer and Stevens brought Grayer in," said Cochrane, who is helping organize the event.

Give a boost to Ames High academics

I would like all Ames High alumni to know about a great group that has been formed at Ames High to support some of their favorite activities.

The Ames High Academic and Arts Booster Club (AABC) is a parent, faculty, and student group formed a year ago to promote and support academic activities, including the visual and performing arts, at Ames High school through supplemental funding and recognition with an emphasis on direct student support.

AABC provides funding through direct requests to a variety of academic- and arts-based groups. Members can also designate that as much as half of their membership money go directly to a specific student activity, such as drama, mock trial, debate, speech, National Honor Society, chorus, orchestra, The Web, Destination Imagination, or the art department for supplies and trips.

In its first year, through parent donations, AABC was able to fund an art class field trip to Grinnell; contributed to the English department's Gatsby party to encourage interest in the literature of that era; purchased a display banner for National Honor Society to use at events; purchased a walnut plaque to display the names of this year's National Merit Finalists; helped fund the Destination Imagination team that qualified for Global Finals in Knoxville, Tennessee; helped fund the visit of Spanish students from Madrid, Spain, which will be reciprocated for Spanish students at Ames High this upcoming spring; helped purchase vocabulary books for sophomore Honors English; and gave an honorarium to a long-term Mock Trial volunteer assistant coach.

In addition, later this fall, AABC will be distributing for the first time money specifically designated by contributors to various students groups. Student groups can then use this money as needed.

Eric Ziebold, executive chef at CityZen restaurant in Washington, D.C., and 1990 Ames High School graduate, was recently honored for preparing one of the top five meals of the year by food and wine reviewer Jerry Shriver of USA Today. CityZen recently received a 5-diamond rating form AAA, one of only 58 restaurants in the U.S. to receive this honor. Food and Wine magazine in 2005 also named Eric one of the top 10 up-and-coming chefs in the country. Eric is the son of Jim and Hilary Ziebold, of Ames.

Aaron Peck, an Ames native, has joined the faculty of the Skidaway Institute of Oceanography in Savannah, Ga., as an environmental chemist and assistant professor. Peck is a 1994 graduate of Ames High School and the son of Steve and Sue Ann Peck of Ames. Previously, Peck was a National Research Council Postdoctoral Fellow at the National Institute of Standards and Technology in Charleston, S.C. Peck is currently working to understand the sources, fate and ecosystem consequences of pharmaceutical, personal care and other unregulated compounds in aquatic systems.

Katie Orazem, 17, a junior at Ames High School, has qualified for the finals of the "National Vocabulary Championship." Launched in September 2006, the event was developed by GSN (formerly the Game Show Network) along with Princeton Review to emphasize the importance of language arts skills and encourage high school students to enhance their vocabularies. The event was broadcast Sunday, April 15, in a one-hour GSN special. Orazem participates as a member of the Ames High School mock trial team and is considering a career as an attorney, possibly in the field of environmental law.

The only person I am in contact with is Bill Sumberg who was a class ahead of me, but we were a pair of rebels who turned out pretty good. Bill is a retired stock broker and Col in the U.S. Army, while I had my own company and was Chairman of the Board of Global Transportation Services, Inc of which I sold some three

years ago. I am semi-retired and did form an international consulting firm so that I can share my expertise in international trade. I am advising the City of Riverside and some firms from Japan.

I am enclosing my check for a three year period and then some. I would like to dedicate this to all of the members of the 1951 football team and the coaches who all gave me direction that helped make me successful in life.
